### HOME GROUPS

We believe that our home groups are a key aspect of our church's life. It can be hard to get to know people and feel part of the fellowship in a large church so by joining a home group you will be able to get to know a smaller group of people and gradually find your own place within the church as a whole. Home groups are, in effect, like building blocks which together make up the larger church fellowship

Home groups provide the opportunity to get to know each other better, study the Bible together, pray and support each other in a relaxed atmosphere. The groups are a safe place to find answers to questions and also to gain confidential support during times of difficulty.

Most people who attend a home group do so because they are fun. Groups regularly have a meal together or organise outings and activities.



### HOME GROUPS

The key aspects of our home groups are:-

- Encouragement - primarily through friendship and hospitality
- Bible study - in order to understand the Bible's teaching and apply it to everyday life.
- Prayer - for one another, for non-Christian friends, and for the church's work of evangelism and world mission.
- Through these key aspects each individual will become more devoted to Christ and thereby strengthen our whole church.
- Home groups meet in the evenings and during the day, group sizes vary from small groups of 5, to larger groups of 12-14. Groups have a wide age range and spiritual maturity.

#### Our Aims:-

- . To express our love for God with our whole life, not just on Sunday
- . To demonstrate God's love to others by meeting their needs
- . To present the Good News about Jesus in an appropriate way for those in our community
- . To encourage, and practically support those who belong to the body of Christ
- . To help people to become more like Jesus in their thoughts, feelings and behaviour
