Prayer focus for June - Faithful in Prayer



This time last year the Rt Rev Dr Martin Fair began his year as Moderator with his message "A new way forward." It seemed most appropriate for us at Fetteresso not only as we sought a way forward in the pandemic but as we sought a new minister. This year in his retiring speech, Rev Fair left us with the words "There is work for us to do."

A year on we give thanks for the answers we have had to prayer. We now have our new minister, Rev Mark Lowey and our new Director of Music, Mr Gordon Cooper and we are back worshipping in Church.

We have begun our new way forward together and now just as Rev Fair reminded us in his speech, "There is work for us to do".

While Jesus was with them, the disciples had watched him work and learned the secret of the Saviour's power. Jesus waited on God in prayer first. We have just celebrated Pentecost. Just as Jesus had told them, the disciples had been faithfully praying, waiting for the Holy Spirit to come and fill them. - 6th. For the work of Matt amongst the children and young people.
- 7th. Pray for those you know and love who do not know God that they may seek and know Him.
- 8th. Ask God to give you an opportunity to extend his love to someone today and then do so.
- 9th. Pray that Mark and the elders may know God's leading and guidance as they meet.
- 10th. Thank God for your friends and neighbours and pray for those who do not yet know Jesus.
- 11th. For wisdom and integrity for those who govern and lead us.
- 12th. Remember again and ask God's healing for all who are suffering from Covid.
- 13th. Give thanks to God for your freedom, peace, safety and all you have.
- 14th. Pray for all facing diagnosis of illness or who are anxiously awaiting results.
- 15th. Give thanks for covid vaccines, pray for their safety and effectiveness and that they might be fairly distributed worldwide.
- 16th. Remember all who mourn today and ask God's comfort and peace.
- 17th. Pray that the Lowey family may continue to settle well here in home, work and school.
- 18th. Pray for safety for all refugees fleeing from their homelands only to be sent back or stuck in holding camps. Ask God to bring hope and a future.
- 19th. Give thanks for all God has done for us at Fetteresso.
- 20th. Pray for an end to all human trafficking.
- 21st. Remember all who continue to be imprisoned for their faith and pray for their release.
- 22nd.Pray for the work of Don Wood amongst the elderly in our community.
- 23rd. Remember Mark and seek God's wisdom, discernment and strength for

him as he seeks to lead us forward.

- 24th. For those seeking work today and those who have just lost their job.
- 25th. Pray for someone who is struggling with their mental health today.
- 27th. Give thanks to the Lord for he is good his love endures forever. Give praise to God.
- 28th. Give thanks for all who work in the emergency services and pray for their safety.
- 29th. Remember all in the armed forces who are separated from their loved ones and pray for the safety of those deployed in places of conflict.
- 30th. Ask God to show you how and where you can serve him.
