Teas and Coffees will restart, after the morning service, on either Sunday 28th November or 5th December.



The arrangement of chairs in church is going to change from Sunday 21st. There will be a central aisle and two side aisles - so that the central block - which used to be 10 chairs - becomes 5 or 6 chairs on each side of the aisle. We will still have a 1m gap between the rows. The congregation can now sit in households (or "bubbles" - of folks they see and meet anyway) and leave a chair between them and the next "bubble". This would, for example allow two couples to occupy a row of 5, leaving a chair between them.

For the teas and coffees, the Hall will be set up "ballroom" style with the red chairs all around the outer walls. The Coffee-Tea-Juice will be served by a small team of 3-4 on the far side of the hall from the church. All drinks will be served in disposable cups with milk being poured by the servers, and sugar sachets/stirrers available. Folks can then stand with their teas/coffees, or sit down on the chairs around the edge. (Again, with the advice to leave a seat between themselves and other bubbles).

They are currently using their flights to deliver Covid vaccine to remote areas.


